**L**um H. Tipsword, Jr., 86, died peacefully in his home, surrounded by family on Saturday, July 21, 2018 at 1:40 a.m. Lum's family will receive friends and family for visitation at Moran & Goebel Funeral Home on Tuesday, July 24, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. and there will be a service to celebrate his life on Wednesday, July 25, 2018 at 10 a.m. Burial will be in Macon County Memorial Park in Decatur, IL.

Mr. Tipsword was born July 9, 1932, in Decatur, the son of Lum H, Sr. and Viola G. (Kinman) Tipsword. He married Mary E. Finney on November 28, 1951.
