**D**arrell Morris Deem, 87, of Decatur, passed away Tuesday, January 30, 2018 in Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Darrell was born on February 2, 1930 in Decatur, Illinois, the son of George William and Elsie Edith (Stogsdill) Deem. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II. Darrell was an over the road driver for Lovelace Trucking and then Schneider Transport retiring with over fifty years of service. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church and enjoyed reading and World War II history. Darrell married Dorothy Hinton on March 30, 1949. They shared over sixty-eight years together.
