Mark S. Shaw, 62, of Sparta, WI formerly of Decatur, died Thursday, October 27, 2016 at his home.

He was born on January 17, 1954 in Decatur to John W and Patricia J (Curtis) Shaw Jr. He attended Stephen Decatur High School. Mark joined the US Army shortly after high school. His military career started with 4 years active duty assigned to Ft Riley, KS. Following active duty, Mark immediately joined the Army Reserves with various assignments at Fort McCoy in Sparta, WI. Mark enjoyed his travel with the Army, spending time in Italy and Germany. He also worked at Cardinal Glass in Tomah, WI until his death. Mark enjoyed playing cribbage with his friends at Linda Lou's, a Sparta establishment. He was a life-long Chicago Bears fan. Mark had a fondness for animals and was a long time ASPCA contributor.
