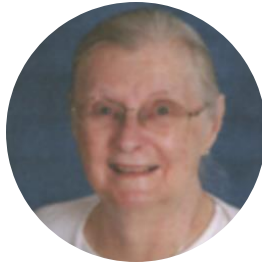

Lillian Louise Landon, 82, of Decatur, passed away into the arms of the Lord, on Saturday, June 4, 2016 at Riverside Hospital in Newport News, VA.

Lillian was born on April 30, 1934 in Jermyn, PA, the daughter of Ralph Henry Harvey and Helen Gertrude (Coons).
