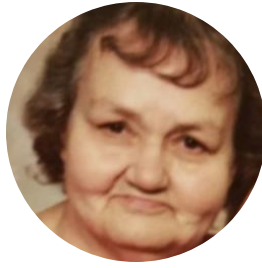

Mary Ann Curry, 77, of Decatur passed away on Friday, April 24, 2015 in St. Mary's Hospital.

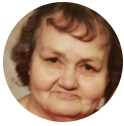
