Decatur – Mark Henry McEvoy, 72, of Decatur, passed away Sunday, March 16, 2014 in Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Mark was born to Mark Mumford and Frances Elizabeth (McNamara) McEvoy on May 2, 1941 in Decatur, IL. He graduated from St. Teresa High School in 1959 and was married Rebecca Sue Hanks in 1975. He worked at PPG and retired in 2003. Mark loved music. He was a disc jockey at WSOY and performed in bands eventually leading the popular Mark McEvoy and the Marksmen. He was active in the community with Junior Achievement, Jaycees, Knights of Columbus, was on the board of the Glass Worker's Union, and was a local Republican Precinct Committee Chairman.
