Sandra L. York- Mahon, 75, of Decatur passed away Monday, April 22, 2013, in Heartland Health Care with family by her side. She was born on June 19, 1937, in Decatur, Illinois, the daughter of Charles and Nora Constant.

At Sandy's wishes, a graveside service celebrating her life will be 2 p.m. Thursday, April 25, 2013 in Graceland Cemetery.
