Julie Jean (Pankey) Sheumaker, 71, of Oakley passed away on Thursday, December 20, 2012 in St. Mary's Hospital.

A memorial service to celebrate Julie's life will be held 1 p.m. Saturday, December 29, 2012 at Moran & Goebel Funeral Home.

Julie was born February 10, 1941 in Decatur, IL, the daughter of Burl and Mary (Fleming) Pankey. She went to school at Eisenhower and was a co-editor of the year book.
