**D**ecatur ' Charles 'Curt' C. Dalluge, 64, of Decatur passed away on Wednesday, October 3, 2012 in Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Curt was born on October 7, 1947 in Moweaqua, IL the son of Charles L. and Billie L. (Harvey) Dalluge. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War, receiving a Bronze Star with a V. device. He was a member of the VFW post 99 and Laborer's Union Local 159. He was an avid boater and camper. He was also a St. Louis Cardinal and Illini Basketball fan. He married Patricia Margias on June 25, 1967 in Decatur.

Surviving are his wife, Pat; son, Charles Steve Dalluge of Decatur; brother, James 'Jim' C. Dalluge (Jenny) of Oreana; sister, Mary F.
