David M. Dougherty, Sr., 71, of Decatur, passed away Wednesday, October 26, 2011.

David "Dave" Dougherty Sr. was born November 14, 1939, in Decatur, the son of John R. and Wilma Kathryn Buzan Dougherty. He was an active member of St. Thomas The Apostle Catholic Church. He owned and operated several family businesses including the D&D Shell/Marathon service stations for 50 years, located at Grand & Water, until his retirement in 2007. The 74-year-old family business was his passion and he valued each and every customer. He also shared his love of cars with his grandkids; working at the station and teaching them to drive his old cars.
