**M**oweaqua-Donovan “Bruno” Brewner, Sr., 80, of Moweaqua formerly of Decatur, passed away 11:55 pm Thursday, July 14, 2011 at Moweaqua Nursing and Retirement Center.

Bruno was born December 15, 1930 in Harrisburg, IL the son of Walter and Christina Moore Brewner. He proudly served his country in the U. S. Army. He was employed by A.E.
