Cathy June Miller, 51, of Clinton passed away on Thursday, November 25, 2010 in her home surrounded by her family.

Cathy was born on May 17, 1959 the daughter of Clarence Wendell and Beverly June Hasler Bryant. She graduated from Clinton Community High School. She attended Richland Community College from 1975-1977 and Illinois Central College in East Peoria from 1977-1980. She graduated from Methodist Medical Center of Illinois School of Nursing in 1981. She also received her Certification as Rehabilitation R.N. from the Illinois Department of Public Health. She worked at OSF St. Joseph Medical Center in Comprehensive Care Unit Critical Care. She was a past officer of the Ladies VFW Auxiliary, YABA Board of Directors, and Women's Morning Bowling League. She was also nominated twice for the Who's Who of American Nursing.
