Mary M. "Marge" Tosetti 78 of Decatur died Sunday September 10, 2006 in Lincoln Manor Nursing Home.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 am Thursday September 14, 2006 in Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church with Rev. Rick Weltin as celebrant.

Visitation will be 5:00 - 7:00 pm Wednesday in Moran & Goebel Funeral Home with a Vigil prayer service at 4:45 pm. Burial will be in Calvary Cemetery at Nokomis, IL. Memorials can be made to Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church.

Marge was born April 29, 1928 in Nokomis, IL the daughter of John and Rose Nagle Coady. She was a graduate of Millikin University and received her master's degree from the University of Illinois.
