Diane C. Collins, 46, of Hoopeston, died at 7:38 AM, Friday, March 4, 2005, at the Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital.

Born Feb. 7, 1959 at Decatur, she was the daughter of Kingston and Marlene Stitt Isenhardt. She married Bruce Ackerman on Dec. 8, 1979, at Decatur. She was later married Andrew Collins on Nov. 12, 1987 at Decatur. He preceded her in death on July 20, 1995.
