Robert L. Morris age 63 of Decatur died at 7:15 pm Monday May 10, 2004 in Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Funeral Services celebrating his life will be 1 pm Thursday May 13, 2004 in Moran & Goebel Funeral Home where visitation will be 5-7 pm Wednesday May 12, 2004 and 12:30 pm until service in the funeral home. Rev. Dan Spruell will be officiant.
