**R**oy Allen Hunsley, 71, of Decatur, died on Thursday, January 08, 2004 in his home surrounded by his family.

Services celebrating Roy's life will be 10:30 a.m. Monday, January 12, 2004 in St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Pastor Wray Offerman officiating. Visitation will be from 4 to 6 p.m. Sunday in Moran & Goebel Funeral Home. Burial will be in Point Pleasant Cemetery.
