Forsyth – Maurice E. “Pete” Kapper, 98, of Forsyth, passed away Thursday, February 29, 2024, at Decatur Memorial Hospital.

Pete was born on November 12, 1925, in Decatur, IL, a son of Aloysius E. and Clara M. (Blank) Kapper. He was a member of Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church and worked at A.E. Staley for 37 years before retiring in 1986.
