In lieu of flowers, the family asks that you take a moment to enjoy life’s simple pleasures, just as Doug always did.






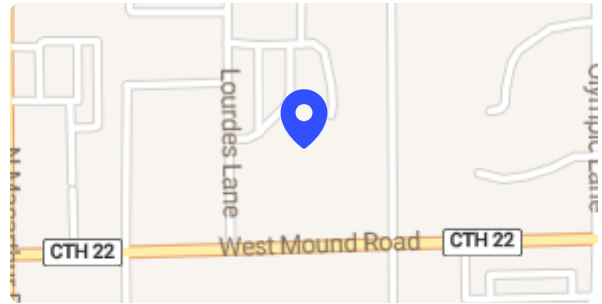
